Sean spent thirteen years as a Hostage Rescue Team (HRT) Operator, Assault Team Leader and Sniper Team Leader, providing leadership, daily training, and responding to numerous crisis sites around the country. He has responded, planned, and operated at numerous critical incidents, national special security events, high-risk arrests, and high-profile hostage rescue missions.

Prior to his service at HRT, Sean served as a SWAT Team leader in the FBI Washington Field Office and the Baltimore Field Office. Sean was certified as a firearm, tactics, active shooter response, chemical munition, and defensive tactics instructor.

Sean also worked as a Supervisory Special Agent instructing at the FBI Swat Operations Unit (SOU) and at the FBI Academy, Practical Applications Unit where he instructed FBI Agents in tactics and firearms. Sean was certified as an FBI Firearms, Tactics, Chemical Munitions, and Defensive Tactics Instructor.

Prior to the FBI, Sean was employed as a Trooper with the Maryland State Police. Sean was responsible for enforcement of Maryland laws, responding to patrol functions, and was a member of the MSP STATE Team.
